A Trophy saddle, Trophy Crown, Potential Scholarship to EOSC
and title will be awarded to the winner.

A Trophy Buckle will be awarded to the runner-up.

A parent or guardian must be present when all tickets are turned in.

No Cash will be accepted. Money order or cashier's checks only made payable to:
McCurtain County Fair Board

You must pay \$100.00 to drop out of the contest.

All contestants must be present each night of the Rodeo on
May 28 & 29 at the McCurtain County Rodeo Grounds in Idabel.

All contestants will be allowed to enter free of charge along with
one parent or guardian each night of the Rodeo Event.

Official Rodeo Dress will be required for each contestant, this will be a cowboy hat,
long-sleeved shirt and boots. All other accessories optional.

All sponsors will be announced each night during introductions of each contestant.

All contestants must complete an application and provide a photo for the newspaper.
