SUBJECT: Livestock Entries and Cattle Weigh In

Monday, May 10th, has been set for the entry/nomination day for market steers and pen of three entries for this year's McCurtain County Free Fair. An entry form is attached with this letter. Bulls and heifers are not required to be brought to the sale barn. However, entry forms for breeding cattle will be due May 10th as well and can be mailed or dropped off at the sale barn during the weigh in times.

The entry process will go as follows.

- Steers and Pens of Three must be brought to the sale barn for entry.
- Cattle should arrive at the weigh in between **9 a.m. and 11 a.m.**
- Steers can go home following the entry process.
- All cattle will be tattooed if tattoos are not present the day of entry. Exhibitors of Market Steers are encouraged to tattoo cattle prior to the weigh in.
- Pens of three will be placed in a pen upon arrival. **Pricing and weighing of pens will take place at 1:00 p.m.**

Entries for Sheep, Swine, and Goats will be due July 1st and you can use the entry form included in this letter for these species as well. Disregard tattoo information for other species.
